After several years hard work by several dedicated members of this Division, I would like to report on what has been accomplished as to the location of both Missouri Confederates who died during the War for Southern Independence and Missourians who died and are buried around the nation and world, also Confederates from others states that came here after the war and are buried here among we Missourians. You may find individual information on each of these men on the Division Web page, left column under the Graves Section of the directory. The below list of counties will show which counties that have had extensive work done in locating these men, it also shows which counties that have been neglected and in need to have your future attention.

To date we have indentified 7717 Missouri who died during the war. There are 1942 grave location for these men, less than 30% are in Missouri. Members have located 6154 CS burial location who survived the war. We have a long way to go with many graves of UCV Veterans & Reunion attendees' still unaccounted for. These men worked hard to leave us this fine organization and it should be our duty to locate as many of them as we can, its the lest we can do, don't you think?
